

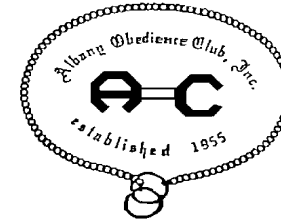

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the East and South: NYS Thruway to Exit 22. Turn left on Route 144, go about 2.7 miles and take left on Wemple Road. Site is about 1 mile on left.

From the West: NYS Thruway to Exit 23. Turn right on Route 9W, go about 3.8 miles and take left on Wemple Road (there is a traffic light). Site is about .8 mile on right.

4. In case of tie scores for a prize, an exhibitor who fails to have his dog compete in the run-off forfeits all rights to such prize. Owners and handlers are responsible for having their dog at ringside when the run-off is called.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Fill in jump heights for Obedience and Rally. Classes will be judged in jump height order.

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the SAME for each day. Check the block for each show in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class on different days (e.g. Open B on Day 1 and Utility B on Day 2) or if you are entering an additional class on either of the days (Open B on Day 1 and Open B and Utility B on Day 2).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Telegraphed, telephoned and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

Mail All Entries With Fees to Barbara Hackel, Trial Secretary, PO Box 191, Niverville, NY 12130. Post dated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Make Checks and Money Orders payable to Albany Obedience Club Inc. CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds.

An AKC Recording Fee of 50¢ first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or other acts beyond the control of the club it is impossible to open or complete the Obedience Trial or Rally Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

No refund will be made for duplicate entries. Every effort to find duplicate entries will be made; however, after entries close, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

The Trial Will Be Open from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges are not required to wait for dogs that are late. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be on leash or crated except when being judged.

All persons attending this event hereby waive any claim for damages against Albany Obedience Club, Inc. or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Please, no campers. RV's absolutely forbidden from this site.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
